
Utilizing the Power Resources Approach for Agency & Power Beyond the Covid Era: KMPDU's Journey

Institutional Power



- We have focused on organizing from class to grave: students to retirees
- We have crossed the employment barrier as the only reason to consider being a union member
- We consider all doctors to be workers and hence potential members of the union.
- Under-employed, unemployed doctors and students in training are part of our membership
- We are organizing doctors in private sector
